

ACTIVE-DUTY SERVICE COURSE FIRE FOR BACK-UP FIREARMS

(CAN BE USED FOR RETIRED OFFICER QUALIFICATION AND OFF-DUTY)

15 Yard Line

From the standing position the shooter will draw their firearm and fire:

6* rounds in **8 seconds**

Reload if needed and holster. On command go to a kneeling position (one or two knees, shooters choice), draw your firearm and fire:

6* rounds **10 seconds**

Reload if needed and holster.

7 Yard Line

From the standing position the shooter will draw their firearm and fire:

6* rounds in **6 seconds**

Reload if needed and stay at low ready. On command fire:

6* rounds **5 seconds**

Reload if needed and holster.

5 Yard Line

From the standing position the shooter will draw their firearm and fire:

6* rounds in **5 seconds**

Reload if needed and stand at low ready. On command fire:

6* rounds **4 seconds**

Reload if needed and holster.

3 Yard Line

From the standing position the shooter will draw their firearm and fire:

6* rounds in **5 seconds**

Reload if needed and holster. On command draw your firearm and pass it to your support hand. On the command to fire:

6* rounds **5 seconds**

Empty your firearm and visually and physically check to make sure it is unloaded and holster.

*Indicates to fire only 5 rounds if you are shooting a 5 shot revolver.

Scoring

48 round course – 240 points maximum 70% = 168 points

40 round course – 200 points maximum 70% = 140 points (5 shot revolvers)

B27 target-8,9,10,X rings=5 points, 7 rings=4 points, hits on silhouette=3 points.

TQ 19, 21 or 22 style many be utilized. Anything within the inside of the scoring ring is 5 points. Outside, but on the silhouette is 3 points.
